## Why and how to donate in memoriam...

By making a donation to Hounds For Heroes in memory of a loved one, you will provide a genuine and lasting tribute to that person. It is a straightforward process and we are always here to help.

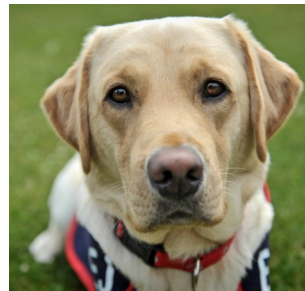
The world post-trauma can be a confusing and daunting place to someone who has been injured or disabled. It is often easier to stay indoors than risk the strangeness of going out and interacting with other members of the community. This leads to lack of confidence and independence as they rely more and more on relatives and neighbours to help. A Hounds for Heroes dog can change that by giving them a reason to go out and experience life, like popping to the shops, going to the pub or even just a walk in the park.

### Why?

All donations received by Hounds For Heroes will help us buy, train and support our dogs and their partnerships for as long as our clients need us.

Many hours go into the training of a Hounds for Heroes dog. From the initial purchase, through puppy walking, advance training and onto partnership and lifetime support. It takes a lot of work and many people are involved in that process. Every partnership takes around 24 months of training, with a further eight years of support required and costs in excess of £20,000 .

To meet the costs of the above as well as food, veterinary costs and vaccinations we really do rely on the support of the general public and the donations they provide.



### How?

It is traditional to give flowers at a funeral, but more and more people nowadays are choosing to commemorate the life of a loved one by donating to a cause close to their heart, or the heart of their loved one. Gifts in memory such as this are especially important to us as they are a very personal and precious way of remembering someone whilst supporting our work.



Donations can be made in several ways,

Either via your funeral director who can collect the

donations in lieu of flowers and send them on to us with a short note. A collection could be made during the service and the donations sent on to us.

Or we can provide special envelopes to use for a funeral collection. These are tastefully designed and can be personalized to include the name of the person you are remembering. The envelopes can be handed back to the person who organized the collections or sent directly to us. Each envelope has a small form with it that people can complete so that we can thank everyone who has donated, and we can also inform the family of the bereaved who have donated on their behalf.
